

CONTEST RULES

Contest: Sustainable Tourism Survey

1. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

No purchase is required. To participate, simply complete the survey once (1) per visit to Sutton. Only one email address may be used to participate, regardless of the number of email addresses owned by the participant.

Any attempt at multiple participation or falsification, including the use of robotic, automated, or mechanical means, will result in automatic disqualification. All entries become the property of the Corporation de développement économique de Sutton (CDES). The contest may be canceled or modified at any time without notice.

2. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- Must complete the online survey during the contest period.
 - Participants must reside in Québec, outside Sutton, and be of legal age as of the contest start date.
 - Employees of CDES, their affiliates, as well as their immediate family members and those living in the same household, are not eligible.
